- Possibly hold it in July so that it can go out in the newsletter.
- People won't be around on the weekend of the 14th with everything going on.
- Possibly have it on June 28 or 29.

Donation presentation -

- Everyone should be in the picture - that can be. We'll put the boards up in the background and the newspaper will take the picture. This could possibly last one hour.
- Voting for the Kid and their Horse pictures will be at the show secretary's desk. Voting will go on throughout the day.

Club Logo -

- Kisha hasn't had a chance to work on this - tabled till next meeting.

Chris Blair Fundraiser Event -

- Possibly have a warm up trail event to run until 10am to raise money for him.
- 5 minutes for \$5 per run.
- Possibly do this at every show.
- We can't have the same pattern as the competition pattern.
- Warm up trail would run from 7am to 10am.
- We will do a trial run at the first show to see if this works; if it doesn't work, we can pass a hat around at the next show and get donations that way.
- A motion was made by Lonnie Scott and 2nd that we have the Chris Blair (Barbie Smith's son) family benefit in the form of a trail warm up, that would be run from 7am until 9:45am, for a maximum cost of \$5 per 5 minutes per go on each show date, with an evaluation after the first show. Vote was unanimous - motion carries.
- Can we set the trail up further down the track because of the babies and other horses that will be in the area during halter? Yes this is not an issue.

VI. New Business

Rules Committee Action Items:

Show Committee Action Items:

- We need a gate person for all of the shows - Carla Wilson - Leff has volunteered to do this from 8am - 4pm for all the shows except July.
- Jill Johnson will be the ring steward for all shows except the August show which will be Jesse Barto.
- Tasha would like to go down the night before the show and get things set up.

ACTION ITEM:

Get together with all show help and run through everything to make sure everyone is on the same page. This will happen on Friday, June 20th at 6pm at the fairgrounds. We will meet at the paddock area. Go over equipment, responsibilities, etc.

- Trail judges will have cards that are printed from the show secretary.
- Show premium will be completed no later than June 6th.

- There is a sign up sheet for show help that is being passed around. It will be on the website as well.
- We need an all day scribe for the announcer. - this can be broken down into time segments. (A scribe is a note taker that will write things down for the announcer and help keep everything organized in the announcer's booth.)

- Sherry needs a member's e-mail list sent to her.

SSA Committee Actions Items:

Fitting Clinic -

- A motion was made by Lonnie and 2nd to have a fitting clinic on the weekend following the horse show, 29th of June. This will be held at Lonnie's house and start at 10am and run till we are done. Futurity fitting will take approximately 4 hours and the performance part will take about 3 hours. Approximately 6 hours to complete this clinic. Possibly have Sean with Nutrena come and talk about nutrition. Cost is \$25 per horse. Members only / horses need to be healthy and have current shots. He will look at the horse and establish a starting place to promote your horse and make him/her as fit as possible. This will cover nutrition, exercise needs; rain or shine. All proceeds go the SSA. Vote was unanimous - motion carries.
- There will be a descriptive ad in the June newsletter.
- Thanked Donna Bochman for turning over the SSA in as good a shape as they were in.
- Need to follow up with stallion owners. Owners are thinking that the SSA Futurity show is a great thing and they are not too sure about the auction being held at this time.

- A letter from Pam Giovanni should be in the mailbox. She has a solid black filly that was born late and she might possibly be donating this filly to the club to raffle off. Pam also made suggestions for things that she would possibly donate - mare care; weeks???? For whoever purchases her stallion. Possibly donating a breeding that is for a drawing.
 - If the filly is donated to the club, we will promote her on the website, newsletter and throughout town so that we can sell tickets throughout the show season.

Business Cards in Newsletter for Advertisement:

- Jenny has been doing a lot of research of other horse clubs and found that several of them offer an advertisement section in their newsletters where businesses can place their business card. The cost is \$60 per year.
- A motion was made by Lonnie and 2nd that we add a business card advertisement page to our newsletter at the cost of \$60/year. Vote was unanimous - motion carries.

Exhibitor Numbers:

- A suggestion was made that people can buy their exhibitor number for the show season as a fundraiser.
- We can provide nice laminated numbers (a set would equal 2 numbers).
- These numbers will have the club logo on them.
- A motion was made by Carolyn and 2nd that as a fundraiser for our horse club, we offer for sale, exhibitor numbers on a first come-first serve basis, so that people can choose their number for the season. Cost is \$20/season (2 numbers).
- Sherry needs a copy of the size so that she can create them.
- They need to be ready by the first show.
- Limited to three digits.
- If they lose them we will charge \$5 per card or they can supply their own number.
- An amendment to the motion was made to charge \$5 per card for replacement cards.
- The number request needs to be submitted to the show secretary a minimum of 7 days before the show.
- Numbers will be supplied at the show if 7 days notice has been given.
- 7 days required to receive your laminated number.
- The motion reads - [As a club fundraiser, we will sell exhibitor numbers, not to exceed three numbers for the price of \\$20 per set of 2 numbers. Replacement cost is \\$5 per card - first come, first serve basis - Numbers will be distributed to the purchaser no more than 7 days after the purchase. Vote was unanimous - motion carries.](#)
- These numbers are per horse - if you have multiple horses, you need to purchase more than one number.
- To avoid mailing fees, the numbers will be attached to the entry forms at the show secretary's desk.
