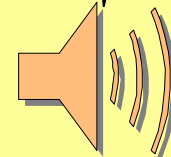

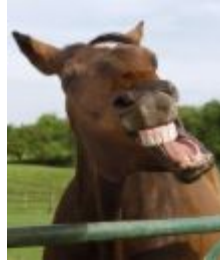

Summer Tips

Summer's here and with comes the heat and bugs, so here are few ideas to keep your horse happy and healthy.

1. Always have plenty of fresh, cool water available (10-25 gallons) a day in the heat.
2. Freeze a bowl of water to add to buckets of water.
3. Try riding during the morning and evening hours when it is the coolest.
4. Make sure your horse is up to date on its shots, especially West Nile Virus.
5. Swat and Repel X lotions are great at keeping bugs from eating your horse alive. Check inside the ears, under the chin and along the belly line, daily. Bugs will actually burrow into the skin and make your horse raw and open to infection.
6. Fly masks and sheets from dawn to dusk are a great help.
7. Putting bug repellent on the belly and privates first before grooming will make it safer and easier.
