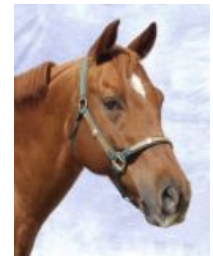

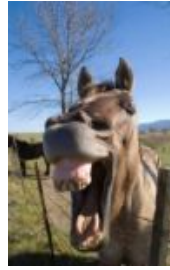

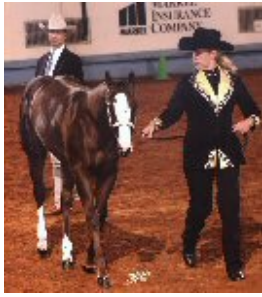

When You Show You Should Know...

AQHA Rule 472 (3-B) states that in **Showmanship** the following constitute “Severe Faults of the Overall Presentation of Exhibitor and Horse” (avoids disqualification but should be placed below other exhibitors that do not incur a severe fault):

- (1) Leading on the off or right side of the horse;
- (2) Complete failure to move around horse by exhibitor and obstructing judge’s view;
- (3) Exhibitor touching the horse or kicking or pointing their feet at the horse’s feet during set up;
- (4) Standing directly in front of the horse;
- (5) Exhibitor wearing spurs or chaps;



AQHA Rule 457 states that in **Barrel Racing**:

- (f) Knocking over a barrel carries a five-second penalty. Failure to follow the course shall cause disqualification. A contestant may touch the barrel with his or her hands in barrel racing.
- (g) A five second penalty will be assessed if the hat or helmet is not on the exhibitor’s person for the entire time the exhibitor is in the arena in barrel racing.

AQHA Rule 454B states that in **Trail**:

(f) The following deductions will result:

One-half (1/2) Point

-Each tick of log, pole, cone, plant, or any component of the obstacle

One (1) Point

-Each bite of or hit of or stepping on a log, cone, plant or any component of the obstacle

-Incorrect or break of gait at walk or jog for two strides or less

-Both front or hind feet in a single-strided slot or space

-Skipping over or failing to step into required space

-Split pole in lope-over

Three (3) Point

-Incorrect or break of gait at walk or jog for more than 2 strides

-Out of lead or break of gait at lope (except when correcting an incorrect lead)

-Knocking down an elevated pole, cone, barrel, plant, obstacle, or severely disturbing an obstacle

-Stepping outside of the confines of, falling or jumping off or out of obstacle with one foot once the foot has entered obstacle; including missing one element of an obstacle on a line of travel with one foot
