ATTENTION

A BOD meeting was held on June 22, 2009, to discuss concerns about a professional showing in a Novice class. A majority of the board members that attended, felt that the activity did not violate our Bylaws and Rules as they are written and so no formal action was taken. A grievance was filed against the BOD and a meeting was held on September 15, 2009.

Question 1 of Portion #1 of Grievance:

Has the BOD failed to take formal action to address an issue that was presented to them for a decision?

Aye—4; Nay—4; did not pass by 2/3 majority

Question 2, part 1 of Portion #1 of Grievance:

Did the BOD take formal action or not?

Aye—1; Nay—7; passed by 2/3 majority

Question 2, part 2 of Portion #1 of Grievance:

Should the BOD have taken formal action?

Aye—4; Nay—4; did not pass by 2/3 majority

Portion #2 of Grievance:

If the BOD considers their action taken to this point sufficient or no further action is needed, does the BOD's decision to allow a known professional horseman to exhibit as a Novice, support our mission statement and the intent of our Bylaws and Rules?

This question was broke out into two parts.

Part 1

Does it support our Mission Statement?

Aye—0; Nay—8; passed by 2/3 majority

Does it support intent of our Bylaws and Rules?

Aye—4; Nay—4; does not pass by 2/3 majority

Vote on whether the BOD feels we need to reject answering the 2nd part of the question because it is worded in a negative way and cannot be answered fairly.

Aye—7; Abstain—1; passes by 2/3 majority

Meeting of the Grievance committee was adjourned.

A meeting was called by the BOD present at the meeting and everyone waived their right to prior notification for this meeting.

A motion was made and 2nd to return the \$50 grievance check since the grievance was considered a concern and not a grievance. Vote was unanimous

Meeting of the Board of Directors was adjourned.
