Awards And Their Requirements For The NENHA 2018 Show Season

Year-End Class Winner

Requirements: Given to the high point scoring horse and rider of any individual class. Contestant must show in that class in at least three of the shows. Winner of division awards will not receive class winner awards for those classes in their division.

Year-End High Point ~ Leadline 6 And Under Division

Requirements: Contestant must show in three of the shows in any or all of the following classes: Leadline Western Pleasure, and/or Stick Horse. May show English or Western.

Year-End High Point ~ Western Performance: 7 years to 10 years; 11 years to 13 years; 14 years to 18 years and 19 and over, Novice And Open Division Requirements:

Contestant must show in at least three of the shows in any or all of the following classes in their division: Showmanship, Western Pleasure, Western Horsemanship, and/or Trail.

Year-End High Point ~ Western Performance: Walk-Trot All Ages Divisions/Kindergarten Classes

Requirements: Contestant must show in at least three of the shows in any or all of the following classes in their division: Showmanship-Appropriate Class, Western Pleasure, Western Horsemanship, and/or Trail.

Year-End High Point ~ Gymkhana: 7 years to 10 years; 11 years to 13 years; 14 years to 18 years and 19 and over and Walk-Trot All Ages Division Requirements:

Contestant must show in at least three of the shows in any or all of the following classes in their division: Barrel Racing, Pole Bending, and two Nevada Bandits coordinated patterns.

Year-End High Point ~ Western Performance: Junior Horse Division Requirements: Contestant must show in at least three of the shows in any, or all, of the following Junior Horse classes: Showmanship-Appropriate Class, Western Performance, Western Horsemanship, and/or Trail.

Year-End High Point ~ English Performance, Youth and 19 and Older Requirements: Contestant must show in at least three of the shows in any, or all, of the following English classes: English Showmanship, Hunter Under Saddle, and English Equitation.

Year-End High Point Halter Horse ~ Stallions, Mares And Geldings Requirements: Horse must be shown in the appropriate Halter class for its age and gender in at least three of the shows. Grand/Reserve Class will include weanlings.

Year-End High Point ~ Reining Requirements: A High-Point winner and a reserve will win year-end awards. All other participants will be eligible for class awards. Participant must participate in at least two of the classes to be eligible for the all-around award. The competitor from all the Reining classes with the highest accumulated score from the judges' scorecards for all the shows will receive a recognition award. Contestants must show in at least three of the shows. These classes will qualify for multiple class awards.

Year-End High Point ~ Ranch Riding Requirements: A High-Point winner and a reserve will win year-end awards. All other participants will be eligible for class awards. Participant must participate in at least two of the classes to be eligible for the all-around award. Contestants must show in at least three of the shows. These classes will qualify for multiple class awards. The competitor from all the Ranch Riding classes with the highest accumulated score from the judges' scorecards for all the shows will receive a recognition award. Contestant must show in at least three of the shows.

All-Around Awards ~ 7 years to 10 years; 11 years to 13 years; 14 years to 18 years and 19 and over, Novice And Open Division

Requirements: The contestant may compete in any, or all, of the classes in their division, as well as Reining, English and Ranch Riding, but must compete in at least two of the following disciplines in at least three of the shows: Western Performance, Gymkhana, Reining, Ranch Riding and/or English. (Although English is not designated as an age or skill division, points in this class will count toward an All-Around Award). No horse may cross enter a Western Pleasure and a Ranch Riding class at the same show. Must be one horse/one rider combination.

NOTES:

- Only NENHA members in good standing are eligible for year-end awards.
- Age division classes are amateur only classes, as are Novice and Walk/Trot
- When an all-around award requires the contestant to compete in at least two disciplines, they are NOT required to show in the same classes at each show. They must compete in more than one discipline in at least three of the shows. Example: Show Open Reining or Open Ranch Riding and two Open classes in Western Performance in three of the four shows.
- Points accumulated in English, Reining and Ranch Riding may only be applied towards one all-around award if contestant has competed in at least three shows in that discipline. If a contestant is participating in more than one division, he or she must select which division to apply the points to.
- Contingent on participation levels, class awards may be given to 1st thru 3rd place.
